

How to Live From Divine Inspiration

Wouldn't it be cool, to live every moment in the perfect will of God. Imagine all your actions coming from the Divine Mind of God! Did you know that you can? It actually is very, very easy. That is why most people simply miss it. It is not the way we are taught to live. In this booklet we will examine two ways of living, by our thoughts or by inspiration. When you are living out of one, you are not in the other.

Our Thoughts

We are taught to aspire. From the day we are born we are compared, criticised, and challenged. Through prideful thinking we aspire to live.

"My baby weighed more, mine walked first, mine graduated high school with a 4.0," and so on and so on. We are taught to, as we put it, "win". We look within ourselves, our intellect, for all the answers. But who is with us, there in the dark confines of consciousness and thought? We are not alone. So every thought, every action, becomes tainted or influenced by that which inhabits us. It is the spirit of someone who knew you well, and lives on in you, their ambitions and their thinking mingling with your own.

So we begin our journey out into this world, this dog eat dog world, to achieve. To be smarter than the other guy and get ahead. We are taught that the guy on the street corner who begs for food just had "bad luck" and we can "make our own luck". This is how we live, from our minds, right where the demon sits, all the while believing or at least trying to convince ourselves we are in control and doing fine. We learn to ignore the innocence that we once knew and we learn to turn a deaf ear to our own conscience, till it too becomes corrupt.

How much influence from these wicked creatures of hell are you under. They already rejected the truth, how much are you moved and influenced by them? If you cannot tell your thoughts from theirs, who's to say who is running the show? Are you willing to trust a demon to help you find God? Do you think they will help you and care for you? If you use your mind as your sole guide, you will die. Actually, this is exactly how to die. You will in fact "think" yourself to death. You will get caught up in your thoughts and fixations like a merry-go-round and live within them and die in them, having never really lived yourself.

False prideful thinking was the first sin. Man thought something other than truth, and followed it. This is the way to death.

So now we know what will happen if we try to live by head knowledge alone, analytical thinking, reasoning, pride, and selfish ambition. For it is the knowing of good (God) and evil (demons) that will kill us. We cannot follow both. One must go, so the struggle ensues and hence comes your stress and guilt.

It sounds difficult. Letting go of a way of life that mankind has always lived by making, planning, sceming, doing, getting, and going. But look at the Truth, the bible says, "Wide is the gate to destruction and many there be that go in it". Do you want to be one of the many? You must begin to "renew your mind" to "pull out of your fixated mindset" and "let the mind of Christ be in you."

What is Inspiration?

Inspiration means a divine influence. If you are led by the Holy Spirit in everything you do then you are living by His divine holy inspiration. What gets in the way of inspiration? Your thoughts. You are what overrides His voice within you by speaking over Him and making your words from your thoughts override Him, the Truth. Because He gave you a free will, you get to choose who you listen to and who you follow and who you believe.

If you try and live out of your own thinking and conclusions, you become your own guide, following your spirit guides. This is how we are taught to live by our peers. This thinking is derived from the concept that man is God, the ruler of his or her own destiny and we follow "self" right off the cliff into oblivian! It is pride that thinks it can "make its own way" and "be its own man" and believes that it can

"reckon" or "make a deal" with God.

Man was not designed to be his own god. Man was meant to walk and talk with God and be at one with God, in fellowship and complete union. This is your purpose. This is who you really are designed to be! So everything outside of that is against the will of God, meaning God's divine purpose for you.

When you follow the "other" voice, you will find yourself much like Adam and Eve, hiding in the bushes from God, hoping He won't see you! Why? Because you have turned your back on your Creator, the only Creator. There is no other place or God to go to for help. There is only One God, One power, One who is Holy and Good. Sin cannot stand in the presence of God, just as darkness flees from the light. So when you have sin (disobedience) in you you are ashamed of yourself, it cannot be helped!

How to do it!

Okay, we know that to live from your thoughts, means that you are living from your conclusions gathered by data, influenced by every wicked thing in you. The bible says we are drawn away from God (Truth) by our lusts. These are the very things that will influence your thinking. Every decision and every action that has an evil basis must go. You never do anything from these "feelings" and in refusing to do so will simply deny the demons any place to live or work from.

Step 1: Do the meditation exercise to distinguish "who" is talking in your head.

Step 2: Do NOT do anything from an evil motive. Never let evil move you.

Step 3: Only move when you see that God is behind it.

Step 4: Always overlook, be patient, and kind of others right on the spot

especially when others are unkind.

Step 5: Repent quickly, when God shows you the truth and don't resent being wrong. You have to drop the pride. It really is okay to be wrong. You only sin against God, not others, and there is no race against your fellow man for spiritual status and importance! Just repent as soon as the Holy Spirit reveals your wrong and don't try and fix anything you've done. God doesn't require it.

Behavioural Example: Someone criticises you and either purposely or inadvertently makes you mad. If you respond in anger, you just moved out of evil. "Nope, you say, I will not be angry,". Your next choice is to overlook (look over and ignore) the error. You see it, you just don't react to with anger. You move out of good and overlook their shortcoming, their sin, and you let it go, why? Many times you did things to upset others. Do you want to be forgiven, then you must forgive. This is just an opportunity to do "God's work", that's all it is. Be thankful that God gave you an opportunity to be forgiven.

Another Behavioural Example: You are faced with a opportunity to tell someone something negative about someone else that will make you look "really good". You stop, see the error, and refuse. Evil didn't move you. You let God move you. Why? You don't care what you look like to others, but only to God. He saw you turn down the opportunity to harm another person. He saw you being like Him. Do you think this would please Him? Yes, you just made your Father smile.

All it is, is really *looking at the source before the action proceeds*. Is it a good source? Then never mind the outcome. Many times you must speak the truth and hurt people's feelings and it is the right thing to do, the difference is "**where**" you are coming from, the source of your doings.

So practice it, in everything you do. **Look at the source and never move from an evil source**. God's guidance will come to you in the moment and you will live by divine inspiration and not by your intellect where demons sit. See, I told you! It really is simple!

If you miss it, just repent, dust yourself off and try again. You are forgiven and cannot sin if you are living like this, because you are overlooking, patient, and kind it means you are forgiving others, and in turn God will forgive you. For you are only forgiven if you forgive, this you must remember. And great peace and love and joy will flood your soul as you do "God's work".

To live from your intellect and follow your thoughts is to do the "devil's work". You are carrying out their thoughts and wishes and believing every rotten thing they throw at you. Fear runs the show and doubt is pulling you this way and that. You can't see for the darkness and even though you try and convince yourself you are fine, you know you are not. For a tree has fruits and yours hang right out there for yourself and everyone to see.

Words are cheap. Anyone can claim to be anything and imaginations can build your ego to an unprecedented height. But it is in what and how you are doing what you do that others see you for who you are and no matter how much you flatter yourself, your fruit is still hanging from your tree. Let me say that again....it is the source, the what and how, that makes the action of God or not. Sometimes, even a good act has a bad motive.

Make life simple and freak out every demon who tries to mess with you! You know how?....just look at the source of your thought....is it good or bad? Did it stem from anger or understanding? Aggravation or patience? Fear or faith? Pride or humility? Why are you doing what you are doing? When God is with you and the source of all that you do, then you can do anything! But do you honestly expect Him to back up the actions, the thoughts, and desires of a demon?

Never let evil move you and you will not be moved by evil!

Once you learn this simple way of life, confusion is over. You no longer wonder if you are doing the right thing. Guilt and pressures flee away as all that you do comes from the Holy Spirit within you. Darkness is gone and peace and joy are abundant.

Always do those things that please the Father. Only carry out the actions that come from Him. These thoughts are humble, kind, overlooking, generous, patient, faithful, honest, peaceful, hopeful, noncritical, etc. It's easy, anyone can recognize evil. Never let evil move you.

Praying

There is an interesting aspect of this knowledge that should be addressed and that is your prayers. Where are you praying from? If you are angry or bitter at someone and you "pray" for them to bring about what "you" want to see in them, this is exactly what witches do. Prayer means "incantation". How does a demon bring about their evil plans? They just use us. Our mouths curse each other, we speak incantations and repeat evil thoughts of that person to keep the curse alive.

The only way to really break the curse is to forgive. If you cannot forgive someone you are spiritually "cursing" them and yourself. This is how witches cast spells, they get really really angry first and that calls the demons to them and they send them to you. Would you like that present? It is only fair, if you are harboring those "hateful" feelings yourself. You see, God is NO respecter of persons. Spiritual laws apply to EVERYONE.

So think about this, next time you drop to your knees in behalf of yourself or someone else. Pray only from that which is "good" inside of you. The more you overlook, and are patient and kind, the more curses you break and the more demons will flee from you. And every curse done or spoken against you will "return to sender" some 10 some 100 fold.
